Transferring/receiving bankbook or cash card is a crime!

Transferring/receiving <u>ID or</u> password for internet banking is also a crime.



To open an account for the purpose of transferring to another person.

To open an account in another person's name or fictious name.

To transfer a bankbook or cash card of your name or another person's name to someone.

To receive a bankbook and cash card of another person's name.

To transfer ID or password of internet banking to others or to receive these items from others. Crime of Fraud Not more than 10-years imprisonment

Violation of Act on Prevention of Transfer of Criminal Proceeds Not more than 1-year imprisonment or 1,000,000 yen in fine.

The account which you transfer will be used by criminals in fraud cases.

Return your disused bankbook and cash card to the bank.
